### **PUBLIC NOTICE**

#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSIT OPERATIONS**

The Customs Administrations of Ghana and Cote d'Ivoire have developed a framework for bilateral co-operation to modernize and facilitate operations of the transit trade between them.

One of the areas of co-operation is the exchange of electronic data and sharing of information between the two countries within the framework of the World Customs Organization's Mutual Administrative Assistance Agreement. (MAAA)

To this end, importers are required to submit export declarations covering goods imported overland from countries in the sub-region.

Declarants are to quote the export declaration number on the corresponding electronic import or transit declaration as an attached document.

The following attached document codes have been created in GCMS for export declarations from Cote d'Ivoire, Burkina Faso and Togo respectively

Export Declaration from Cote d'Ivoire	83

With effect from March 12, 2007, all electronic import and transit declarations submitted through **Elubo, Paga** and **Aflao** shall bear the correct export declaration number from the country of exportation.
