**INTRODUCTION OF ELECTRONIC CLEARANCE OF GOODS AT
THE CEPS AKANU AND KPOGLO STATIONS ON THE EASTERN
FRONTIER**

The Customs Excise and Preventive Service announces for the information of Traders, Declarants, Agents and the Public at large that the Customs offices at Akanu and Kpoglo under the Aflao Collection in the Volta Region have been connected to the GCNet and the Ghana Customs Management System (GCMS).

2. Consequently, the existing manual procedures at these offices will cease to operate with effect from 18th May 2009. From this date, Traders will be required to use the Front End system (FES) to input the Bill of Entry and all details of attached documents. Traders will receive payment advice which will be presented to the Collecting Banks in the settlement of duties and taxes and all other charges which are due.

3. These arrangements are part of the computerization programme to make clearance processes transparent, easy and faster for trade facilitation and enhanced revenue collection

4. It is expected that traders will avail themselves of the facility and comply with all requirements.
